Our National Youth Chances research found 52% of LGBTQ young people self-harming and 42% considering suicide.

- More pupils report that they feel confident in reporting HBT bullying, feel more resilient towards bullying, and feel their school is inclusive towards LGBT pupils and families
- Staff, pupils and parents/guardians are engaged, empowered and motivated to reduce HBT bullying
- More schools have policies and curricula targeted at preventing and tackling HBT bullying
